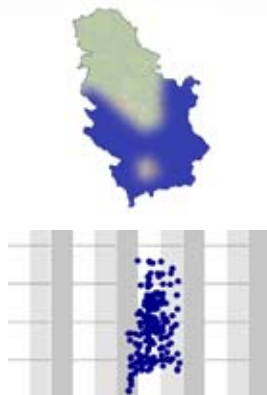




Scarce copper
Lycaena virgaureae

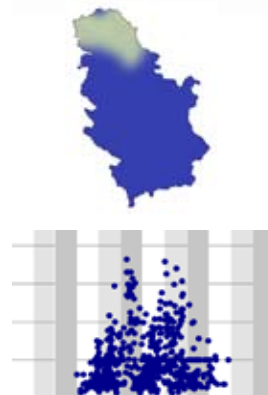


30-34 mm

Recognizable by vivid orange colour and little white spots on the underside. Inhabits mostly central and eastern Europe. In Serbia most common in mountainous areas, in wet and boggy meadows sheltered by forest, and clearings on the roadside.



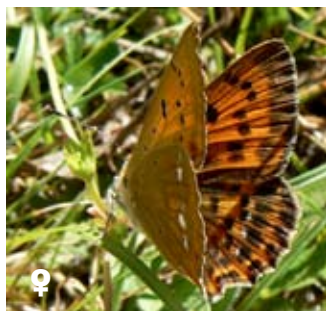
Sooty copper
Lycaena tityrus




28-30 mm

Upperside of males is recognizable by dark colour, females by characteristic pattern. It is found on many grasslands. Considered most common copper, both in Serbia and entire Europe.
